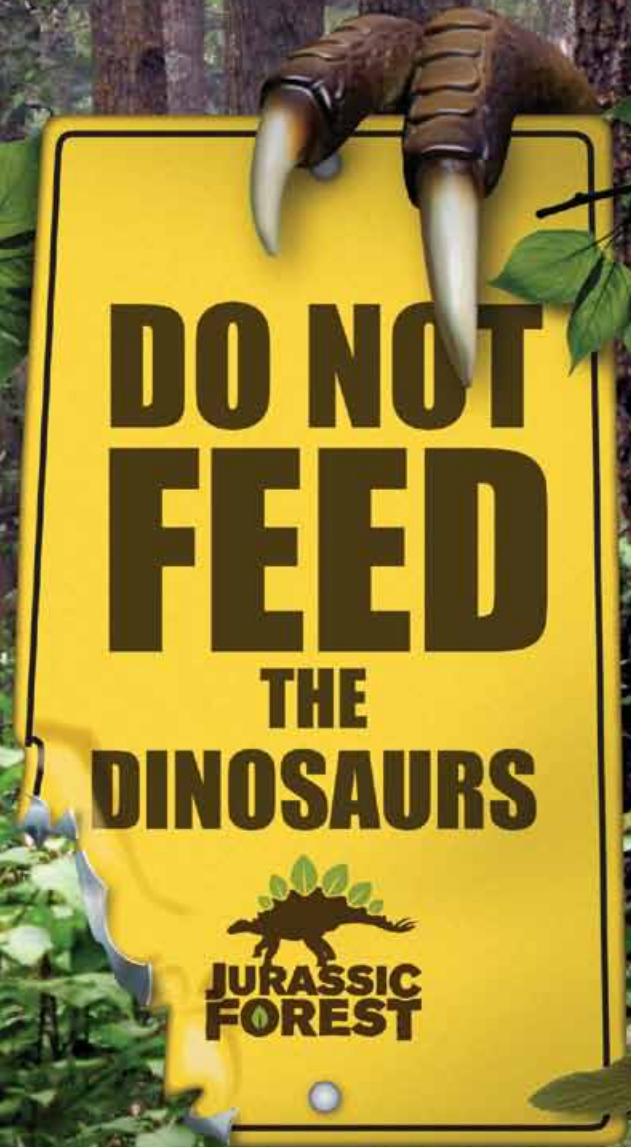
## SURVIVING IN JURASSIC FOREST
