Jurassic Forest is so much more than just dinosaurs!

Our on-staff educators have developed programs suitable for a wide variety of curricula. Our natural forest and wetland setting is a unique opportunity for students of all ages to learn about ecology, natural history and the environment. We have also developed programs utilizing features of our natural forest setting and our extensive knowledge of dinosaurs to create one of a kind language arts, mathematics, and social studies based learning experiences.

### PLANNING YOUR FIELD TRIP

If you are taking part in our interpretive tour, your group will be assigned an appropriate number of interpreters to take you through the guided tour and/or programming. Please note our interpreters are not responsible for supervising students. We require at least one adult supervisor for every 10 students, regardless of which package your group is planning to do. Additional adults/supervisors are always welcome!

Special needs/educational groups are very welcome. Our wooden walkways are wheelchair friendly, and we have handicapped accessible washrooms right on-site. Please let us know ahead of time if you would like some assistance bringing your group off the bus and into Jurassic Forest and we will have staff standing by. While Jurassic Forest has a strict no pets policy, service animals are permitted.

Groups are welcome to stay as long as they like, regardless of the number of programs you initially signed up. Consider planning and conducting your own programming here at Jurassic Forest.

You are invited to make use of our picnic grounds and play area. Arrangements can be made for students to store their lunches and backpacks in a safe area while they are enjoying their programming. We do have a small concession with snacks, juice, pop, coffee, tea and hot chocolate available for purchase.

## QUICK FACTS ABOUT JURASSIC FOREST AND LEARNING CENTRE :

- 2.0 km of wooded walkway trail system, in two loops of approximately 1.0 km each
- 41 animatronic dinosaurs dispersed throughout the forested area and interpretive centre
- Average guided tour is 1.5-1.75 hours, and we recommend 3.5 to 4 hours for your complete visit
- Benched areas throughout the walkway systems allow for resting opportunities
- Over 100+ interpretive signs are distributed throughout the trail system
- There are no washrooms on the trails, all washrooms are at the main facility
- Outdoor picnic table seating for 250 people
- In case of rainy weather, arrangements for limited inside eating areas can be made
- Gift Shop items are offered, with prices for smaller type items starting at \$1.95 each
- Concession offers hot dogs, snack type foods, chips and popcorn, a variety of ice cream and frozen items and full array of beverages and juices – item prices range from \$1.50 to \$3.50 each
- In case of inclement weather, Jurassic Forest remains open at all times. All field trips that are postponed due to weather are rescheduled as soon as possible to another day, as availability may be an issue.
